Colorado Photographers Exhibition
Deadline July 31, 2007

Six Colorado photographers will be chosen to display their six-image portfolios in the Center's gallery for this special exhibition. The date of the Colorado Photographer's Exhibition is October 2 - 6 2007. The opening and reception is Friday, October 5 during the Fort Collins Gallery Walk.

The Center for Fine Art Photography invites **Colorado** photographers working in all mediums, styles and schools of thought to participate in this exhibition. Traditional, contemporary, avant-garde, creative and experimental works that include old and new processes, mixed techniques, and challenging personal, emotional or political statements are welcome.

Theme: Open - There is no specific theme for this exhibition. The images should be from the same body of work. The images will be evaluated as a body of work, rather than as individual images.

Eligibility: The exhibition is open to all Colorado professional and amateur photographers working with digital or traditional photography or combinations of both.

Juror: Larry Padgett, Executive Director, The Center for Fine Art Photography

Awards:

All exhibitions provide opportunities for artists to present their work to an international audience of collectors, curators, art consultants and others who appreciate the fine art of photography.

- Six Colorado photographers will be chosen to exhibit 6 images each during this special exhibition.
- Juror's Selection award: \$300, plus their selected portfolio published in *Artists' ShowCase*, the feature section in *CameraArts* magazine
- All six photographer's will have at least one image selected for *Artists' ShowCase* and will receive a 1-year subscription to *Artists' ShowCase* Online, the Center's new online image marketing website (preview at www.artists-showcase.org). If already a subscriber, the subscription will be extended an additional year.
- All exhibitor's works will be included in the Center's online gallery
- All exhibited work will included in the Center's *2007 Exhibition Collection* CD which is distributed to selected galleries, collectors, design houses and corporations world wide

Submitting Entries for Jurying

Entries are submitted via the Center's on-line system. Click on **Call for Entries** on the homepage to begin the process. Photographers will submit a body of work consisting of 6 images. More than one body of work (6 images) may be submitted, but each body of work will be juried separately.

>> Note: images previously accepted by The Center for Fine Art Photography for exhibition in the previous 12 months are NOT eligible. Images submitted but not accepted for exhibition may be resubmitted as often as you wish. <<

Entry Fee

- The entry fee for this call for entry is \$55.00 for Members and \$65.00 for Non-Members for each body of work (6 images).
- There is no limit on the number of bodies of work (6 each) that may be submitted.
- The annual Membership dues is \$45.00 through May 31; \$57.00 as of June 1, 2007. Photographer's signing up for membership at the time of entry will be charged the Member entry fee.

Preparing Images to Upload Online:

Please follow these requirements when preparing your images for submission:

- Your images are viewed as RGB images using Adobe RGB 98 or SRGB profile. NOTE: CMYK files will not upload.
- The largest image dimension (width / height) should be 800 pixels with the other dimension proportional.
- Save your images with a resolution 72 ppi as flattened, 8 bit JPEG files (16 bit files will not upload.)
- Use JPG compression quality of 8.
- The image title can not be greater than 40 characters.
- File names can not include any of the characters listed below or have more than 25 characters.
Do not include #,\$,&, periods or other similar characters as part of the file name.

Acceptance Notification

A list of accepted artists will be posted on the Center's web site. Also, artists with accepted entries will be notified by e-mail and receive shipping instructions at that time. The email address to which notification will be sent is the email you provided in your profile. If it changes in the interim, please log in and update your account. ***If you use a spam blocker, white list exhibitions@c4fap.org.***

Exhibit Prints (This applies to accepted work – not submissions for jurying)

The Center strives for uniform framing as the image is the artist's work, not the framing. Uniform framing is less distracting to visitors when compared to an exhibition with many different colored mats and framing styles.

For this special exhibition, The Center requires all accepted work be printed and enclosed in a 16 x 20 inch mat. All work will be displayed in the Center behind glass using L hooks. At the same time, the Center recognizes that some work (avant garde, mixed media and experimental work, for example) incorporates the "framing" as an integral part of the presentation. If this applies to your work, please contact the Center.

Otherwise, the Center will **require** that all work adhere to the following:

- Matted image size will be 16 x 20"
- Work is **not** to be framed, but matted only
- *Bright white* mats are required. They may be single, double or triple (off white or cream is not acceptable)

Sales

Sales of all work is encouraged. Artists will state the retail sale price of their work. The Center encourages sales during the exhibition and retains a 40% commission on all work sold.

Use Rights

By submission for jurying, artists **whose submissions are chosen for the exhibition** grant The Center for Fine Art Photography the right to use their images for the purpose of marketing the exhibition, marketing the Center's programs and subsequent display on the Center's website of past exhibitions. Artists grant the use of their image(s) as stated without further contact or compensation from the Center. Artist's recognition is provided with use.
