International Peace Corps Show

Deadline: May 29, 2008

The Center for Fine Art Photography in cooperation with **Beet Street**,* will be hosting a show of photographs created by Peace Corps Volunteers during its long history. The **2008 Peace Corps Exhibition** will take place in Fort Collins, Colorado during the **International Peace Corps Reunion**. Selected images will be exhibited in the Center's gallery during the reunion, August 20 – August 30, 2008 and on the Center's website for two additional years. There are also plans for a traveling exhibition.

Eligibility: Pictures created by current and former Peace Corps Volunteers will be accepted. The photos must be of events and everyday life during a Peace Corps Volunteer's tour.

Juror: Dr. Anthony Bannon, Director of the George Eastman House in Rochester New York.

Important Dates

- Images due, either online or by mail: May 29, 2008
- Notification will begin June 10, 2008
- Exhibition dates are August 20 – August 30, 2008
- Peace Corps Reunion is August 22 – August 24, 2008

Submitting Images

- Images may be submitted online - *This is the preferred method*
- Images may be submitted as 4 x5 inch (10 x 13 cm) or larger prints – *Negatives and slides will not be considered*

Submitting Images online

- Please visit the Center's website at www.c4fap.org, click on the *International Peace Corps Show* to begin the process.

Preparing Images to Upload Online: Please follow these requirements when preparing your picture for submission. If you are unfamiliar with these technical guidelines for digital files almost any digital image from your camera or from an in-store lab will likely work just fine. So if the following is unfamiliar, just try uploading your image as is. If there is a problem, you will get an error statement. You can then call The Center for Fine Art Photography for assistance at 877-664-1010.

- Your images are viewed on monitors as using standard Adobe RGB 98 or sRGB profile.
NOTE: **CMYK** files will not upload.
- The largest image dimension (width or height) should be 800 pixels with the other dimension proportional.
- Save your images with a resolution 200 - 300 ppi, any layers flattened, 8 bit JPEG files (**16 bit** files will not upload.)
- Use JPG compression quality of 9. This compression level will not affect the quality of images viewed on a monitor.
- The image **title** can not be greater than 40 characters. (Image title is *not* the image file name)
- Image file names can not include any of the following characters or have more than 25 characters. Please do not include #,\$,&, periods or other similar characters as part of the file name.
- There can only be a single period – just prior to the file format extension, example: filename.jpg
- During the image upload process, please provide a short (250 character maximum) descriptive information for each image including City / Region, Country and the event.

* **Beet Street** is an independent cultural and economic development entity of the Fort Collins Downtown Develop Authority

There are three steps to submitting images:

- **Create an account** – this information is automatically linked to your images
- From your Account Services page, choose **Register and Submit Images** . . .
- You'll next be asked if you want to become a member of The Center for Fine Art Photography. Membership is not required. You can scroll to the bottom of the page and click on **Not at this time**
- The next page lists all of the Center's current calls for entry. Click on the **Peace Corps Exhibition**, the **Select** at the bottom of the page.

The following page provides details about uploading your images.

If for some reason you can not upload all of your images at one time, you can exit the program, reenter at a later time by logging in, and continue where you left off. The login link is in the top left corner of the page.

Submitting Your Images by Mail

- Mail your **4x5 (10 x 13 cm)** or larger photograph to:

- Include with each photograph submitted (limit of 5 per person) the following information:
Typed or Clearly Print
 - Your full name
 - Your mailing address
 - Your email address
 - A typed description of the image including the City or Region, Country and approximate Date and information about the scene photographed, including peoples names if possible.
- Put each image and the above information in a separate envelope
- Put all of the envelopes in a single envelope and mail to the above address – to arrive *no later than* May 29, 2008

Entry Fee

There are no fees for submitting images. The show is underwritten by Beet Street, the sponsor for the Peace Corps Reunion. You can learn more about Beet Street and the reunion events at www.BeetStreet.org

Acceptance Notification

Everyone whose image is selected will be notified beginning June 10, 2008. An email from the Center will be sent as well as a list will be posted on the Center's website, www.c4fap.org ***If you use a spam blocker, please white list exhibitions@c4fap.org.***

Exhibited Prints

- Digitally submitted images will be printed by Fine Print Imaging (www.FinePrintImaging.com)
- Prints smaller than 8.5 x 11 inches (22 x 28 cm) may be scanned and printed to a larger size by Fine Print Imaging
- The Center will mat all the pictures prior to hanging the show.
- There is no cost to the print owner

Sales

Photographs will not be for sale during the exhibition. All images selected may be considered for the permanent collection in the Beat Street Peace Corps Reunion Museum or for a traveling exhibition. Beet Street will contact individuals following the exhibition.

Use Rights

By sending in images or submitting them on line, the owner of the image(s) grants The Center for Fine Art Photography, Inc. and Beet Street the right to use the owner's image(s) for the purpose of marketing the exhibition, marketing the Center's programs and subsequent display on the Center's website of past exhibitions. Owners of the image(s) grant the use of their image(s) as stated without further contact or compensation from the Center. Owner recognitions will be provided with the use of images.
