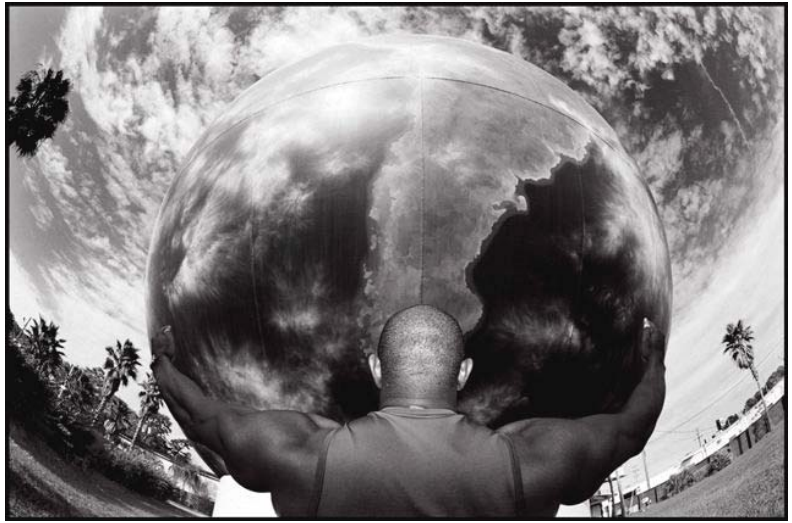

The Center for Fine Art Photography presents its newest exhibition, *Perspective*. This exhibition is on display in the Center's gallery from March 20 through April 18, 2009. The artists' and public reception will be held at the Center from 6-9pm on Friday April 3.



*Perspective* offers the audience a variety of viewpoints, from the strategic placement of the camera to the photographers' ideas and opinions. Juror, Paula Tognarelli, Executive Director of the Griffin Museum of Photography stated, "Photography enables us to see the world from a variety of vantage points. It can be a vehicle to explore and understand our many differences as well as join us with a common thread."

Forty-six photographers representing Belgium, Canada, Germany, United Kingdom and the United States are exhibiting their work in the Center's gallery.

Founded in 2004 to promote the art of photography through exhibitions and education, the Center is a non profit organization supported by donations, grants and memberships. The Center for Fine Art Photography currently has more than 1,000 members representing 33 countries worldwide. Although its headquarters, gallery and soon-to-open wet darkroom are in Fort Collins, Colorado, an on-line gallery gives photographers and photography enthusiasts from all over the globe an opportunity to engage with the Center.
