The Center has a wide range of ongoing volunteer opportunities.

Gallery Attendant:

Greet Center visitors and answer general questions about our organization and exhibition. Regardless of your knowledge of photography, gallery attendants who enjoy people and greeting guests are best fitted for this position. Saturday shifts 10am to 12:30pm and 12:30pm to 3pm are available.

Opening Receptions:

Each exhibition, the Center hosts a public and artists' reception. Volunteers are needed to count visitors, greet guests, bartend, prepare food, and take pictures of the event. Outgoing and personable people seem to like this position best. Openings are every First Friday of each month from 6pm to 9pm.

Exhibition Installer:

Every month the Center installs a new exhibition. Volunteers are needed to paint walls, measure and handle photographs, hang images and place labels. People that are interested in the 'behind the scenes' look of gallery preparation are best suited for this position. Hours and days vary.

Administrative Assistant:

The Center is a beehive of activity Monday through Friday. People with professional customer service and administrative skill are needed to answer phones, type documents, file paperwork, inventory images, and assist with office operations. Hours and days are flexible.

Workshop Assistant:

The Center presents workshops and forums on a weekly basis. Some workshop instructors need help setting up chairs and tables, preparing digital equipment for presentations, taking roll, collecting tuition and putting equipment away. Volunteers interested in learning more about art and photography fit best into this position. Hours and days vary.

Darkroom Monitors:

Darkroom monitors must have at least an intermediate understanding of darkroom techniques. Monitors will need to take a short training course to introduce them to the Center's darkroom facilities. Hours and days vary and may include nights and weekends.

Public Relations/Marketing Liaison:

With numerous ongoing exhibitions, educational programs and events, the Center needs skilled professionals with public relations and strong communications skills to promote and market the Center's events. Hours and days scheduled with Center staff.

Editors/Writers:

The Center produces documents, blogs, web content and other written content that needs to be reviewed and edited. People with background in English and have strong verbal and written skills are needed for this position. Hours and days scheduled with Center staff.

Fundraiser/Grant Writers:

The Center is a nonprofit 501(c) 3 organization that needs funding for exhibitions, traveling shows, youth and educational programs, and major events. Professionals with experience with fundraising and grant writing are appreciated. Hours and days scheduled with Center staff.

Construction/Builder:

With the Center's expanding facilities, people with strong construction and building experience are greatly needed to maintain and improve the Center's facilities. Hours and days vary by project.

Gardener/Landscaper:

If you love being outdoors and landscaping, this is the job for you. The Center's new courtyard is in full bloom and needs some TLC. This is a great opportunity for people who appreciate gardening or landscape artists to experiment with new projects.
